Contest Rules & Regulations

With photo submission, participants are assumed to understand and agree to the following:

- Submissions will be accepted via email from Sunday, November 1, 2020 through Saturday, November 28, 2020.
- Limit of one submission per person
- The contest is divided into three categories: Grades K-5, Grades 6-12, & Adults (ages 18 and up).
- Photos must be original with no editing/filters and must not infringe on copyright law.
- Photos may not contain human faces.
- Each photo will be judged for impact, composition, quality of lighting, and representation of the autumn theme.
- The winner in each age group will be determined by a library judging panel and will receive a \$30 Amazon Gift Card via email.
- Winners will be notified via email and will be announced by Friday, December 4th on Flat River Community Library's Facebook page. The judges' decisions are final.
- Participant's name and submitted photo may be posted online or otherwise used in publicity materials.
- The contest is open to amateurs only (no professional photographers).
- Participants must be residents of Montcalm County or students of Greenville Public Schools, St. Charles, or Flat River Academy.
